Instructions for Use

Hydrocolloid Wound Dressing

Simpurity[™] Hydrocolloid Wound Dressing is a thin hydrocolloid sheet that accelerates the healing process by providing an ideal environment for formation of granulation tissue. The dressing forms a gel upon absorbing wound exudate providing a moist wound environment, supporting granulation and epithelialization. The gel formation prevents the dressing from adhering to wounds and can be removed without causing pain and without damaging the new tissue.

Application:

- 1. Clean the wound with sterile cleanser or saline water and dry the surrounding skin
- 2. Choose the right size of dressing to cover the wound according to wound area
- 3. Remove liners from the back of the dressing
- 4. Apply the dressing to the wound bed

Changing Frequency:

Simpurity[™] Hydrocolloids high absorption capacity binds away excess exudate prolonging dressing change intervals. The dressing is slightly transparent enabling wound inspection. It is recommended to change this dressing three (3) times a week.

Indications:

Simpurity[™] Hydrocolloid Wound Dressings are indicated for the management of light to moderately exuding wounds such as: second-degree burns, leg ulcers, pressure ulcers, chronic slow healing wounds and abrasions and can be used as a blister treatment.

Contraindications:

The product is not indicated for third-degree burns, on exposed muscle, bones or tendons and infected wounds.
