Instructions for Use

Foam Wound Dressing

Simpurity™ Foam Wound Dressings contain a moisture permeable barrier layer designed to protect against exudate strike-through while acting as a protective barrier to outside wound contaminants. Simpurity Foam dressings are designed to be easily removed from wound sites. The non-adhesive construction of the dressing helps to assure that the skin around the wound perimeter is not damaged.

Application:

- 1. Clean the wound with sterile cleanser or saline water and dry the surrounding skin
- 2. Choose the right size of dressing to cover the wound according to wound area
- 3. Apply the dressing to the wound (apply the white foam side to the wound. This dressing has a plastic backing to eliminate strike-thru)
- 4. Cover and secure the dressing with medical tape or a transparent dressing.

Changing Frequency:

Dressing change frequency will depend on the patient's condition and the level of exudate. This dressing is recommended to be changed three (3) times a week.

Dressing Removal:

Gently remove the tape. Peel from the edge of the used foam dressing to remove it from the wound bed. Repeat application steps.

Indications:

Simpurity™ Foam dressings are indicated for the management of moderate to heavily exuding wounds such as: pressure sores, leg ulcers, cavity wounds and can be used as a protective padding.

Contraindications:

The product is not indicated for third-degree burns or surgical implantations.
